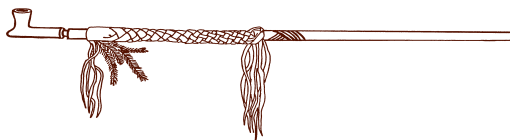

Note: This listing is not all inclusive of the Yuchi National Archive holdings. In addition to the 70 some references noted herein, the Yuchi Archive currently contains bound texts on the Melungeons (14), East Tennessee & SW Virginia History (14) and more than a hundred texts on general Native American Studies with supporting material not specifically Yuchean character.

No attempt has been made to make this listing alphabetical or to make it conform to any formal bibliographic protocol, it is merely intended to be a quick reference to the holdings of the Yuchi National Archive materials. Several texts are listed but have eluded acquisition so far due to expense.
